Local elections are taking place across the country on 4th May for parish and town councils. Burstwick Parish Council received seven nominations for the nine seats, meaning two seats will be filled by co-option following the uncontested election.



What do local councils do?

that provides services for the residents of the parish. The council provides allotments, manages the play area and the cemetery, produces a village newsletter and looks after Festive Field recreation space. The council meets once a month to make decisions on behalf of the village. The parish council as a corporate body are also charity trustees for Burstwick Village Hall.
