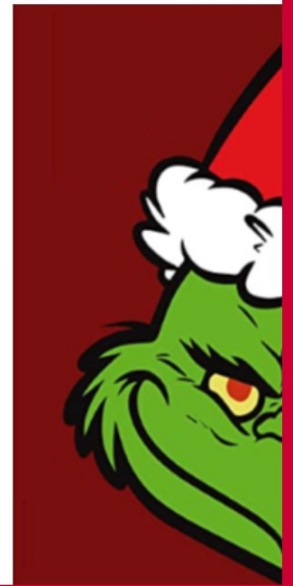

Equipment was funded by Burstwick Parish Council and a grant secured from Burton Pidsea Community Wind Farm Fund.

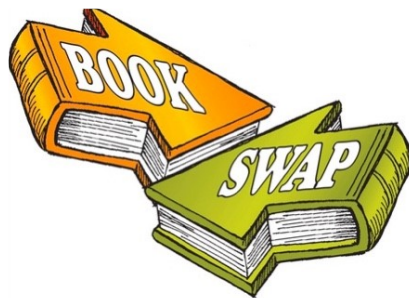


## VILLAGE HALL BOOK SWAP
