## THE QUEEN'S PLATINUM JUBILEE 2022

In 2022, Her Majesty The Queen will become the first British Monarch to celebrate a Platinum Jubilee, seventy years of service, having acceded to the throne on 6th February 1952 when Her Majesty was 25 years old.

An extended bank holiday, from Thursday 2nd to Sunday 5th June, will provide an opportunity for communities and people throughout the United Kingdom to come together to celebrate the historic milestone. The four days of celebrations will include public events and community activities, as well as national moments of reflection on The Queen's 70 years of service.

Parish Councillors along with representatives from the Village Hall Management Committee and residents have formed a working group to focus on Burstwick celebrations.

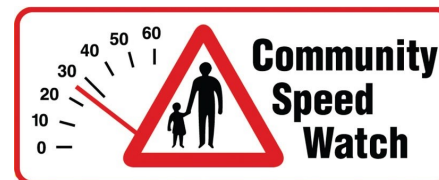

## COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH

## HONORARY FREEDOM OF THE PARISH

Burstwick Parish Council recognise the efforts of members of the community who demonstrate outstanding commitment to the wellbeing of the village. The Council do this, in special circumstances that meet the criteria of the Honorary Freeman/ Freewoman Policy. This honour is awarded only on rare and exceptional occasions. One person, unless otherwise decided by the Council, may be awarded the title in any one year.



A framed certificate was presented to Mrs Rosalie Angell on 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021, by Parish Council Chairman Cllr. Dean James and Vice chairman Cllr. Alison Brown.

Mrs Angell was awarded the Honorary Freedom of the Parish in recognition of her long voluntary service to a range of community groups and fundraising in the village.

Cllr. James said "Rose's voluntary commitment and dedication has demonstrated outstanding service to the wellbeing of our community. It gives me great pleasure to award the certificate on behalf of the Burstwick Parish Council".
